1. You study at a leading Australian global business school

S P Jain Global is also registered with the Skills Future Singapore Agency (SSG). Furthermore, the EMBA degree is attested by the Qatar Government.

2. Our innovative EMBA has been crafted over many years

We launched the EMBA in Dubai in 2004. Since the launch, we welcomed 140+ batches (as of April 2025), making the EMBA one of the most successful programs worldwide. The program's underlying philosophy is a Constant And Never-ending Improvement

(CANI). Recent developments in 2024 have included integrating Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) throughout the curriculum including introducing a new course, ESG and Ethics for Leaders. Further innovations include harnessing the use of Generative AI. EMBA students studying online can also choose to take the Strategic Management course on the Dubai campus.

3. Career growth, during and after the EMBA

The EMBA curriculum focuses on building visionary and transformative future leaders. It enables students to apply knowledge, skills, and capabilities to create value for themselves and their organisations. These capabilities include critical thinking, problem-solving and solution generation, decision-making, creative innovation, time management, effective written and verbal communication, and an all-around capacity for leadership. There are many examples of career acceleration and adaption during the students' studies and afterwards as alumni.

environments. Amongst the many features is the opportunity to do a specialisation in Marketing, Finance, Operations and Entrepreneurship, or no specialisation should a student choose.

5. Engaged Learning Online (ELO) technology

The EMBA uses the school's world-class and leading-edge Engaged Learning Online (ELO) technology to enhance the students' experience. As of April 2025, S P Jain Global houses 14 ELO studios across its campuses. ELO effectively mimics teaching in a physical classroom, with a big emphasis on engaged learning. 6. Project-based learning

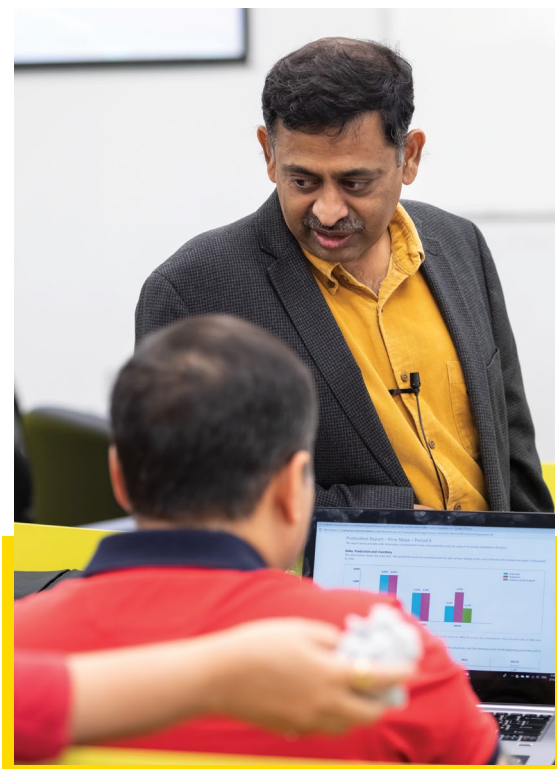

Strategic Management Intensive Course

The Strategic Management Intensive Course is a unique opportunity for our online students to experience the vibrant learning atmosphere of our Dubai campus. Conducted over four consecutive days by our top global faculty, the course brings a rich international perspective to the classroom. This unique face-to-face experience goes beyond academics, fostering collaboration, idea-sharing, and personal growth.

Multimedia Business Simulations

Today, businesses operate under conditions of high risk, complexity and unpredictability. In this scenario, it is important for business leaders to understand the many intricacies of the business world and prepare for them in a focused manner. At S P Jain Global, computer-aided business simulations are used extensively in our state-of-the-art simulation centres to enable students to practice and sharpen their real-world decision-making skills in an innovative, risk-free environment.

Examples of simulations our students have undertaken:

- **Mt Everest:** Enhances leadership skills and fosters strong group dynamics through immersive challenges

Executive Career Acceleration Pathway

The Executive Career Acceleration Pathway (ECAP) is a 1-credit course designed to help EMBA students enhance their professional and interpersonal skills for job readiness and career growth. Offered throughout the 18-month program, ECAP provides a personalised learning journey tailored to each student's needs. Through one-on-one career coaching, CV and LinkedIn enhancement sessions, specialist workshops, and corporate interface events, students gain the tools to accelerate their professional development. They also benefit from networking opportunities with EMBA alumni and can join the S P Jain EMBA Toastmasters Club, available in Dubai, Singapore, and Mumbai.

Global Strategy Immersion Project

The Global Strategy Immersion Project (GSIP) is a 2-credit course that equips EMBA students with practical strategic expertise. Working in teams, students plan, organise, gather critical data, and perform a comprehensive analysis of a global company's market entry strategy. As the most extensive group project of the EMBA program, the GSIP challenges participants to combine logical, fact-based analysis with innovative, solutions-oriented thinking.

By exploring a company's potential expansion into a new market, teams deliver well-justified, actionable recommendations for short, medium, and long-term strategies. This immersive experience prepares students to tackle the complexities of global business with confidence and insight.

Applied Strategic Project

The Applied Strategic Project (ASP) is a cornerstone of the EMBA program, providing students with the opportunity to tackle a significant, real-world business challenge. Spanning four months, this is a 5-credit project designed to address a topic of strategic importance to the student's employing organisation and often aligns with the chosen specialisation. Under the dual guidance of an academic mentor and an industry mentor, students ensure the project meets both rigorous academic standards and practical, industry-relevant outcomes.

The ASP is seamlessly integrated with the Research Methodology course (2 credits), which equips students with the essential tools and techniques to conduct advanced research effectively. Many students have leveraged the insights and outcomes of their ASP to drive impactful changes within their organisations and achieve notable career advancements.

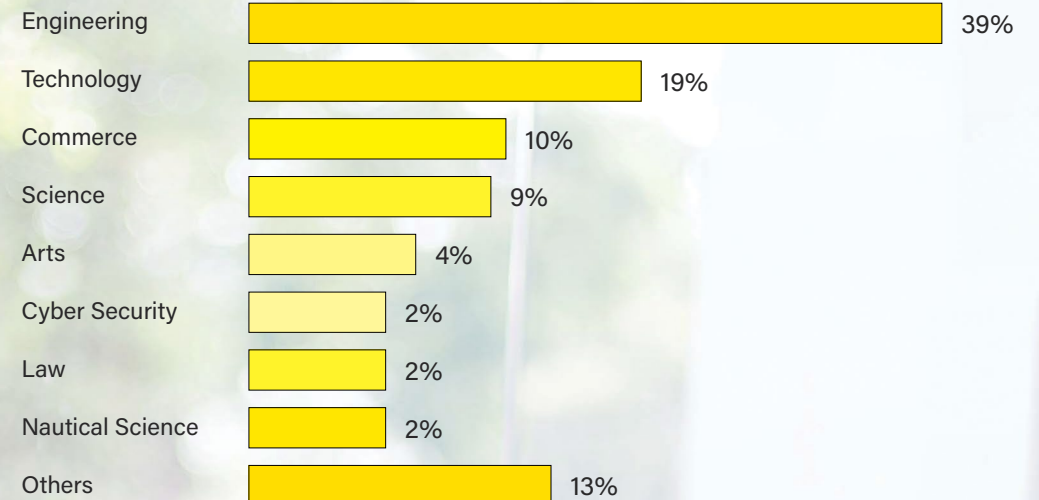

How to join

1. Eligibility

All applicants (domestic and international) must have:

- An undergraduate degree from a recognised university or an approved tertiary institution
- Evidence of having worked after graduation on a full-time basis in a role which has been assessed by S P Jain Global as relevant to the course of study for a minimum period of 3 years

In exceptional cases, and no more than 5% of a cohort, professional experience deemed equivalent to an undergraduate degree may enable consideration for eligibility, subject to the approval of the Dean.

English language entry requirements

Applicants who have not completed their most recent education qualifications in English are required to take any of the following recognised formal English language tests and obtain currently valid minimum scores as below:

- IELTS score of 6.5
- PTE score of 60
- TOEFL IBT score of 70

2. Application

The application can be submitted online at no cost.

3. Entrance test

Applicants must appear for the GMAT, GRE, GMAC Executive Assessment, CAT (Common Admission Test – offered in India) or SPJAT (S P Jain Aptitude Test) and achieve an acceptable score as listed in the Postgraduate Admission

and Selection Policy (For more information: www.spjain.org/ijfud).

Candidates may apply even if they have not yet taken the aptitude test, or if their scores are pending.

However, candidates will not be shortlisted for an evaluation interview until they submit their final test scores. S P Jain Global accepts the best score from the stated tests.

4. Evaluation

The School establishes a shortlist of potential applicants based on:

- Past academic performance and other achievements
- Past work experience
- English language proficiency
- Outcomes and scores of aptitude tests

All shortlisted applicants will be notified by the school in writing.

As part of the final stage, all shortlisted candidates will be required to undertake a final evaluation comprising:

- An essay
- A personal interview with a member of the school's selection committee. The interview may be conducted on-campus or online and is designed to assess the applicant's communication skills, analytical abilities, aptitude, and subject knowledge.
